Memorandum to the Prime Minister of Bangladesh

Sheikh Hasina Prime Minister of Bangladesh.

Honourable Prime Minister,

The Assamese community in the United Kingdom is deeply concerned about the so-called foreigners' problem in Assam. Thirty-two million people of Assam have been in agony for a long time over the issue of migrants who have come into Assam in large numbers, and have occupied government land and constitutionally reserved tribal belt land. People of Assam think that a large proportion of these migrants had come from Bangladesh. The Assamese diaspora of Great Britain have been thinking about these problems. We think that cognisance of the issue by the Government of Bangladesh will help to heal aggression in Assam and to solve the problem in a more humanitarian manner.
